Increased Capacity

- Three times the physical size of MSA Hospital
- Double the number of health care professionals
- 300-bed capacity for future growth (opening with 261 beds) including:
 - Ten new maternity beds for a total of 28 single-bed rooms
 - Increase of special care nursery beds from eight to 12 and pediatric beds from 12 to 18
 - Expansion of ICU to ten beds plus eight transition stepdown beds
 - Eight new cardiac care beds and an increase of telemetry beds from 12 to 16
 - 14 new acute geriatric beds
 - Ten new oncology beds
 - Ten new palliative care beds
 - Doubling the number of mental health beds to 40
- Increase in the number of operating rooms from five to eight plus a dedicated maternity operating room

The Abbotsford Regional Hospital and Cancer Centre, a \$355 million project, is on time, on budget and within scope — an unprecedented achievement in a health care project of this size and complexity.

Enhanced Services

- Specialized obstetrics and special nursery care with increased pediatric outpatient services
- Enhanced infection control with 20 per cent of rooms capable of isolation and a ten-bed dedicated secure isolation unit for serious outbreaks
- Expanded emergency department with pediatric area, geriatrician specialist and psychiatric clinical decision unit
- More space for ambulatory care clinics

New Services - Fraser Health

- Nuclear medicine
- Renal dialysis for kidney disease treatments
- Specialized child and adolescent psychiatry unit
- Cardiac pacemaker capacity and separate cardiology unit
- Acute geriatric program
- Specialized palliative care beds

New Services - BC Cancer Agency

- Estimated 60,000 annual patient visits
- 12 chemotherapy chairs
- Four linear accelerators for radiation therapy
- Patient access to national and international clinical trials
- Supportive care, nutritional consultation and rehabilitation
- Pain/symptom management and palliative care
- Hereditary Cancer Program
- Breast health services in collaboration with Fraser Health

The Abbotsford Regional Hospital and Cancer Centre will be an important regional referral hospital for the Fraser Valley and a key hub in the BC Cancer Agency's provincial cancer control network.
