Evaluation Process

The evaluation committee, which included both clinical and non-clinical representatives of Fraser Health and Partnerships BC, evaluated the proposals that came back in response to the request for proposals. The committee was helped by four specialist sub-teams to assist in the evaluation of the proposals in the following areas: design and construction, technical, services, financial and commercial.

The committee's recommendations were provided to the Fraser Health board for discussion and consideration. The board then voted to endorse the committee's recommendation of the preferred proponent and directed that negotiations with BC Healthcare Solutions begin.

The total cost for the project is not yet final and will not be available until negotiations have concluded. Once a project agreement has been signed, a project report summarizing the value for taxpayer dollars achieved will be released.
