- Since 2002 Infrastructure BC has led the procurement of 64 completed projects across Canada valued at \$23 billion.
- Infrastructure BC services include project planning, including procurement analysis (through Concept Plans and Business Cases), procurement management, design and construction oversight, contract administration, and project communications support.
- Infrastructure BC is a self-sustaining organization operating on a fee-for-service basis, governed by a Board of Directors, and reporting to the Minister of Finance as its sole shareholder.
- Infrastructure BC is currently managing eight projects in procurement. The delivery models for these projects include Alliance, Design-Build, Progressive Design-Build, Design-Build-Finance, and Construction Management.
