I was appointed Fairness Monitor on this Project on January 9, 2023. This constitutes my Fairness Report on the RFSQ process.

In discharging my obligations as Fairness Monitor, I received and reviewed the RFQ and the Evaluation Guidelines to determine whether any fairness issues were extant in those documents. I found none.

In addition, I was copied on correspondence exchanged between the contact person and the proponents under the RFSQ and, including RFIs and RFCs exchanged between the parties.

Finally, I attended the Evaluation Meetings of the proposals received and monitored for any fairness principles arising during that process. When fairness issues did arise, I was satisfied they were resolved without any residual fairness concerns.

In summary, I found the procurement process on this RFSQ to be in full compliance with all applicable fairness principles, including transparency, due diligence and the absence of bias being demonstrated towards any one or more of the proponents. In addition, I found those responsible for the management of the process to be keenly aware of the need to abide by fairness principles and to exemplify that understanding in their activities during this phase of the procurement.
